



I take pride in folkloric music of my country full of arcana, in the wondrous music which only has one key to the mystery in every region. Mugham music as well as modal music are historic proofs of this pride. This is the voice of Ali Ghapoo, of Arg-e Bam, of Naghsh-e Jahan, of Vakil Bazar, of Eram Garden, of Saadi, Hafiz and Molana's poems, of Babak Castle, of unforgettable history and civilization, of culture of people of the motherland, an age-old voice speaking of nooks and crannies of the East and unveiling ancient mysteries. I have made an endeavor to decipher a drop of this unfathomable ocean. I have composed this music as a tool to express these feelings.
